



Living with COVID-19 in our community

What are the Rules?

As of June 30, 2022

Travel

Apply to Travel

- Vaccinated travellers are required to complete a Travel Declaration at least 72 hours prior to departing for the islands.
- All unvaccinated travellers, including children, are required to apply on the Travel Cayman Portal 5 days prior to departing for the islands and will be issued with a travel certificate which is required for entry.

Note: The requirement for a travel application does not apply to cruise travellers.

Pre-Arrival Testing for Travellers

- There is no requirement to undergo a COVID-19 test prior to arriving to the Cayman Islands.

Quarantine

- Vaccinated travellers are exempt from quarantine requirements.
- Caymanians and residents are exempt from quarantine requirements.
- All other persons will be required to isolate for a period of not less than 7 days unless they are under the age of 12 and travelling with a vaccinated adult.

Travelling with Children

- Unvaccinated visitor children under the age of 12 years old will assume the vaccination status of their adult travel companions.

Post-Arrival Testing for Travellers

- All travellers are strongly encouraged by the Medical Officer of Health to complete daily lateral flow tests for their first seven (7) days post-arrival.

Community

Masks

- There are no government requirements to wear a mask in most public places. Owners and/or operators of establishments may require the use of a mask before entering their establishment.

Testing Positive

- All persons who test positive for COVID-19 by lateral flow test must complete a PCR test to confirm their result.
- Vaccinated persons are required to isolate for a period of no less than 7 days.
- Unvaccinated persons are required to isolate for a period of no less than 9 days.
- There is no requirement for a person to test once isolation has been completed.
